Hello family. I am truly grateful to have been given the opportunity to serve. After a two decade long absence from the RSC, it was a great experience to return. Thirteen out of twenty-three areas were represented in Wrightsville Beach on October 10. The positions of Facilitator and Co-facilitator were vacant due to resignations. Those roles were ably filled for the day by our Regional Delegate and the alternate. The PR chair also submitted his resignation. Dave P of the Sun City Area was elected as Facilitator beginning at the RSC in January and Jordan R from the Coastal Carolina Area is the new PR chair.

There will be a Zonal CAR Workshop in Charlotte on Saturday from 6-9 PM. I will confirm the time. If it is different, I will let everyone know. It will be held at the Sheraton Airport on Billy Graham Parkway. Our RD and Alternate RD are willing to do workshops for areas but they ask if, to minimize travel, conjoining areas can get together to cohost.

As long as a meeting is listed on the region's directory, it is covered by the blanket insurance policy. If a facility requires proof of this, either existing or new, please let me know.

Regional donations are down somewhat, but we are still okay. If the trend continues, we may see services curtailed, but that is not imminent.

Years ago, when I was active in Literature Review, the regional LRC published a newsletter called the Carolina Freedom Express. It is now in the process of revival as an electronic publication. More will be revealed as to when we will see the finished product. Personally, this is exciting news.

PR had \$450 added to their annual budget to cover travel, website, and supplies as they are now becoming an active committee. Another \$113 and change was approved to reimburse the web coordinator for the transition to the new host, which should provide a more stable website able to handle more traffic.

The next RSC will be in Myrtle Beach on January 9th. Exact location to be determined. The April RSC will be in Wilson, NC

I would like this area to consider offering to host or even cohost with Greater Charlotte an upcoming RSC, perhaps next October.

I again want to thank this area for the opportunity to serve the area, region and the fellowship.
