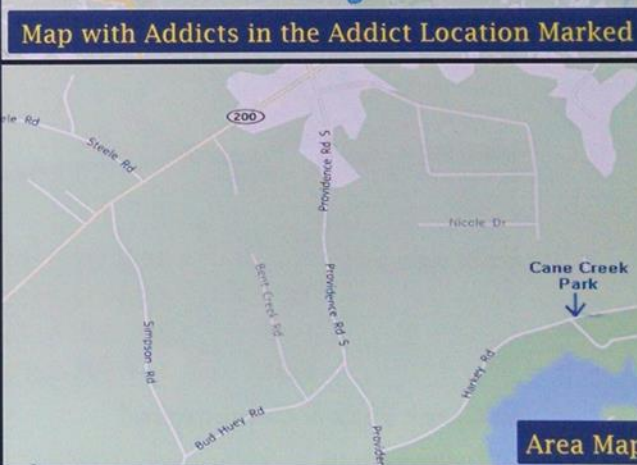
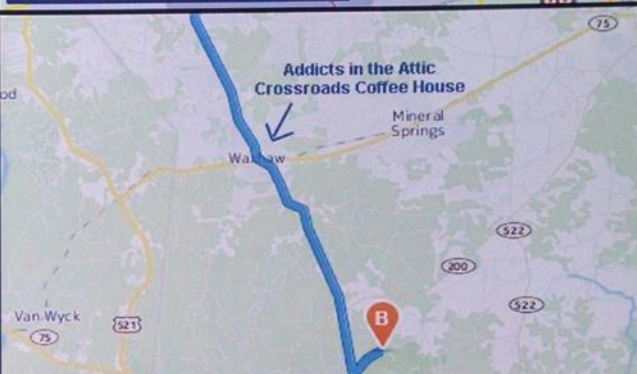

Directions

From I-485 and Providence Road

- Take Providence Road Towards Waxhaw (South) Travel 9.9 Miles
- Turn Left at Stop Light after Train Tracks onto E South Main (NC-75) Travel 0.3 Miles
- Bear Right onto Old Providence Road. Travel 1.8 Miles
- Turn Right onto Providence Road S. At Waxhaw Baptist Church Cemetery. Travel 4.9 Miles
- Turn Left onto Harkey Road, Cane Creek is 1.1 Miles on the Right

From Monroe

- Take Highway 200 South 11 Miles
- Turn Left on Potters Road go 2.5 Miles
- Turn Right on Harkey Road go 1.4 Miles
- Cane Creek Park will be on the Left

From 521 (Johnston Road) and I-485

- Take Highway 521 (Johnston Road) South towards Lancaster to Highway 75. ~12 Miles
- Turn Left onto Highway 75. Travel 4.5 Miles.
- Bear Right onto Old Providence Road. Travel 1.8 Miles
- Turn Right onto Providence Road S. Travel 4.9 Miles
- Turn Left onto Harkey Road. Cane Creek is 1.1 Miles on the Right.

From Lancaster

- Take Lancaster Highway (SC 200) North 8.1 Miles (Turns into NC 200)
- Turn Right onto Simpson Road. 1.0 Miles
- Bear Right onto Bud Huey Road. 0.8 Miles
- Turn Sharp Right onto Providence Road S 0.4 Miles
- Turn Left onto Harkey Road Cane Creek is 1.1 Miles on Right
